Schmidt remarked to Buffett that they looked like Dead Heads in costumes...or "parrot heads." Jimmy laughed and passed the name on to the crowd and inadvertently christening them forevermore, "PARROT HEADS."

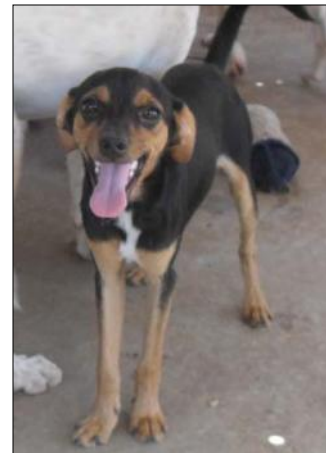

Blue Hawaiian

- 1 oz. Light Rum
- 2 oz. Pineapple Juice
- 1 oz. Blue Curacao
- 1 oz. Creme de Coconut
- 1 slice Pineapple
- 1 Cherry
