Parrot Poop *Parrot Pete*

Radio Margaritaville is doing a weekend countdown of Jimmy Buffett's Top 40 songs as voted on by the Sirius/XM listeners. I am listening as I write Parrot Poop and the number two song triggered my thoughts for June - the song is "One Particular Harbour."

"One Particular Harbour" was released in October 1983 as a single 45 rpm and as an "album." Other songs on the album are: "Stars on the Water", "Twelve Volt Man", "Brown Eyed Girl", "We Are the People Our Parents Warned Us About". Back up vocals were Rita Coolidge and Timothy B. Schmit - wow!



So where is the OPH? The island is Moorea in French Polynesia. It is part of the Society Islands, 9 miles northwest of Tahiti. The harbor is Cook's Bay. I first learned of Moorea at a Camden Buffett tailgate. I met a sailor and friend of Jimmy Dreamz, who set out to sail to all spots Jimmy Buffett had sailed and he had been to Moorea. Never ran into that chap again, but what a fascinating Buffett fan and what tailgate in Philly/Camden! Still one of Buffett's favorites.

Jimmy is quoted as finding his OPH when he did a concert in Tahiti, promoted by Tom Moffatt (Hawaii's famous concert promoter). Jimmy asked Moffatt to set up the show and they played to an unknown audience that spoke little English. After the show, an old expatriated American named Hugh Kelly took Jimmy to his island paradise on Moorea in the mountains above Cook's Bay. That was it - One Particular Harbour was written.

The song begins with lyrics in Tahitian:

Ia ora te natura
E mea arofa teie ao nei

Translation: Life to Nature, Love the Earth.

Each person's One Particular Harbor is a very personal thing. Is it where one goes to get away, to be by oneself? Is it someone that is always there for you, thus your OPH? Please take time to think about identifying your OPH. If you do not have that place or person, I urge you to spend valued time discovering your One Particular Harbor.

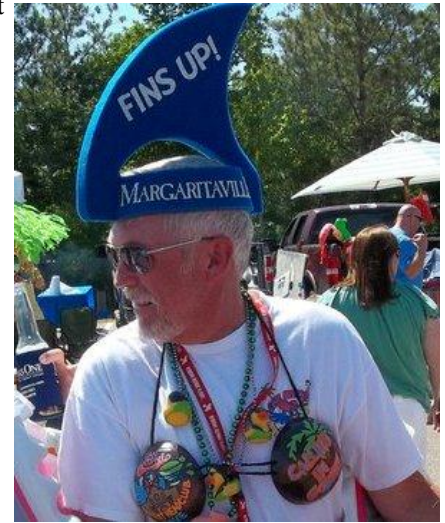
Where in the Phlock is Cooler Dave *Dave Spenny*

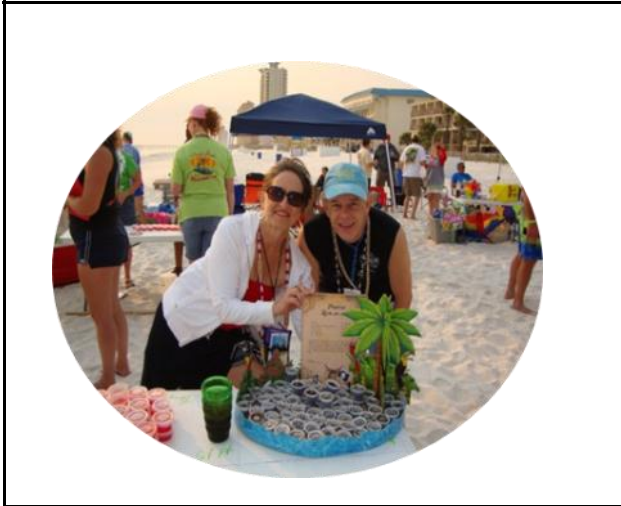

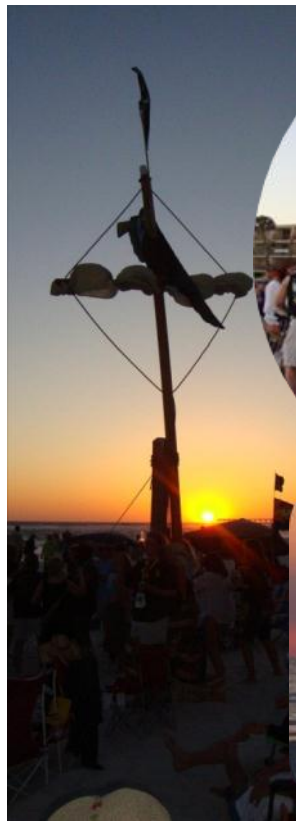

Pirates' Rum-de-Vous

Winning Jell-O Shot Recipe at 2011 Parrot Head Rendezvous

- 1 cup sugar
- 2/3 cup Hershey's Special Dark cocoa powder
- 1 cup half and half
- 1/2 cup white rum
- 1/2 cup coconut rum
- 1/3 cup amaretto
- 1 1/2 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1/2 t. almond extract
- 1/2 t. coconut extract
- 1 2/3 envelopes of plain gelatin
(plus an extra dash of gelatin)
- 1/4 cup cold water
- 1/4 cup boiling water



Place gelatin in a small bowl and stir in the cold water. Meanwhile, in a large mixing bowl, mix all other ingredients except boiling water until thoroughly combined, at least five minutes. Pour boiling water over gelatin mixture and stir well. Pour this mixture into main bowl and stir in well. Pour into shot cups and refrigerate for at least two hours or until set. Enjoy.

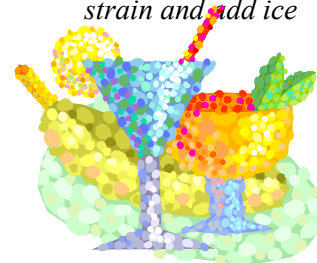

Parrot Head Profile: Frank and Nancy Danek

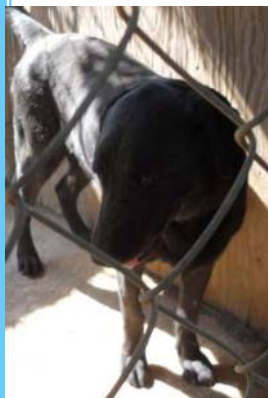
